Thank you for considering nominating your horse to the Fall Classic Sale! Please read through the nomination package and if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to one of our admin team. We are here to assist you in selling your quality horse for a good price. We will do our best to help you market your horse and bring more bidders to you. In order to do this, we need your help by providing us with as much high-quality marketing material that you have available, including show video, professional show photos for the performance horses and well written catalogue notes. For the Broodmare, Weanling, Yearling, 2-year-old and Prospects please include in your catalogue notes siblings from the mother-line doing well in sport as well as any accolades that your young horse has achieved such as foal inspection results, broodmare inspection results and any related offspring's achievements. On the Presentation days you will need to present a well prepared, professionally turned-out horse. We cannot market what we do not have on video or photos!

## How to Proceed

- ✓ Nomination Deadline is **August 10th, 2021**.
- ✓ Complete the fillable PDF Nomination form and email to [admin@cwaction.ca](mailto:admin@cwaction.ca) (include a photo of your horse)
  - Complete and send all attachments required. IE Wire transfer info, credit card authorization form
  - Scan the horse's registration certificate or proof of pending registration
  - Scan the EC/USEF/FEI passport for Performance horses (we are looking for the page with the passport #)
- ✓ Admin fee due when nomination form completed and submitted. Etransfer [ettransfer@cwaction.ca](mailto:ettransfer@cwaction.ca) ..... **\$150**
- ✓ Once your horse has been accepted into the sale you will be notified by email. No later than **August 20<sup>th</sup>**.
- ✓ You will then be required to do the following:
  - Pay the balance of the Nomination Fee (see acceptance email for amount).
  - Catalogue notes submitted **NO LATER THAN August 27<sup>th</sup>** for the nominated horse, its sire and dam. All corrections, edits and revisions **NO LATER THAN September 10<sup>th</sup>**. The more detail the better on your horses' and or their close relatives' successes.
  - Conformation photo of the horse standing in the open stance taken from the side and/or photo of the horse at a competition.
  - Video of the horse competing is very helpful in selling a performance horse for a good price. Please provide **NO LATER THAN September 10<sup>th</sup>**. These will be included on your horses' auction page.
  - All nominated horses will be required to attend one of our 3 presentation days.
    - Presentation days will be **August 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>** – Location Old Gate Farm, Olds AB. **All horses must have a Current ELISA/Coggins drawn not before June 1, 2021 to attend the Presentation days.** \*This test will be valid for sale requirements\*
    - Please check the appropriate box on the nomination form and a representative will contact you via phone / email to confirm your date and time. We will do our best to accommodate your request.
    - During the presentation day your horse will be professionally videoed and photographed during the performance part of the presentation. In addition, professional conformation and head shots will be

taken, all of which will be used for marketing and sale purposes. All of this marketing material will be available to each consignor for their own personal use as well.

- ✓ Consignor must be a current member in good standing with CWHBA to attend the **Presentation Day**. Please contact us for a fillable form and we will be happy to assist in getting your membership up to date.
- ✓ Sold horses will be insured for 10 days following the close of the sale
- ✓ The seller is obligated to provide board at no charge for up to 10 days following the close of the sale

## Terms, Conditions, Limiting Criteria & Governing Policy

### BASIC ELIGIBILITY

Horses eligible for nomination must be registered Canadian Warmblood or with another recognized Warmblood registry (as in 1 and 2 below):

1. Warmblood registries which are recognized with WBFSH include, but are not limited to:

2. Providing horses meet CWHBA standards for warmblood registration:

### LIMITING CRITERIA

- Priority will be given to CWHBA horses with a limited number of Non CWB and imports being permitted at the discretion of the sale committee
- Special consideration **MAY** be giving to horses with an exceptional show record / siblings from the direct mother-line with exceptional show records that the sale committee feels will be an asset to the Fall Classic Sale
- 40 lots will be accepted for the sale
- Other Limiting criteria will be based off of Performance and / or Pedigree.

In your nomination, please include as much information as possible about your horse's performance record, schooling shows, ability (free jump video for a jumper prospect or free movement for dressage prospects), other noteworthy siblings out of the dam-line and any other pertinent information for the selection committee to make their decision.

<b>Prospects</b> * Must be 3 to 6 years of age	Prospects – 4 years or older – must be started under saddle 3 years old – started under saddle <u>or</u> ready to start under saddle. Preference MAY be giving to horses that are started.
<b>Performance Horses</b> * Must be 5 to 12 years of age	Performance horses must have shown at a minimum of two EC or USEF rated shows or have proof of attending five schooling shows in the past 18 months. Preference MAY be giving to horse with an outstanding show record.

<b>Broodmares</b> * Must be 15 years of age or under	Broodmares must be 60 days pregnant at sale time and have a pregnancy confirmed between September 13 <sup>th</sup> and 22 <sup>nd</sup> . Meet breed eligibility requirements (including inspection) and have been covered by a stallion entered in the CWHBA studbook. They must perform the same basic PPE as weanlings and yearlings.
<b>3 in 1 Package</b> Mare in foal, with foal at side package	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Mare IN foal with a foal at her side must be 60 days pregnant at sale time and have a pregnancy confirmed between September 13<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. The mare must perform the same PPE as a broodmare and the foal must perform the same basic PPE as the weanlings and yearlings. 3-in-1 Package is an additional .. \$150</li> <li>■ Mare with a foal at side who comes up <b>NOT</b> in foal must then meet the same PPE and x-ray requirements as a performance horse or choose to withdraw from the sale. The foal can then be solely offered at auction and a \$150 refund will be given.</li> </ul>
<b>Weanlings</b>	It is recommended that they are shown at their dam's side, although may be shown without. Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness.
<b>Yearling *</b>	Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness. Basic x-ray requirement is recommended but not mandatory.
<b>2-year-old prospect*</b>	Must perform the PPE as required by the sale committee, which includes trotting for soundness and basic x-ray requirement.
* All age categories are as of January 1 <sup>st</sup> of the year of nomination	

## Nominations

- All owners agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will provide the sale with all required veterinarian documentation including: x-rays, EIA, insurance forms, vaccination record, medication form and videoed flexion tests that will be sent to the admin team by the dates specified in the 'Important Dates and Deadlines' section below. Failure to do so will forfeit all fees and your horse will not be sold through the sale!
- All owners agree that by nominating their horse(s) they will allow them to be tested for any banned substances according to the Equine Canada Medication Control Committee. Every horse will have blood drawn at their PPE and it will be held for 45 days after the sale.
- Where the owner of a horse is a partnership, limited company, ranch or farm all legal signatories must sign the nomination form.
- All information and representations of the horses consigned are the sole responsibility of the seller or agent of the seller.
- The seller acknowledges that each horse consigned is free and clear of all liens, warrants and encumbrances.
- All original papers and passports must be turned into our office no later than the presentation days, along with the corresponding, signed transfer of ownership forms. The Sales Admin can assist you with all documentation. In the case of a pending registration, the registration form and the transfer of ownership must be completed, DNA included (20 hairs from the root) with the DNA form and turned into our office no later than the presentation days.

# Fees, Commissions and Disbursements

**NOMINATION FEES** – All Fees Payable Via E-Transfer (etransfer@cwauktion.ca) or Credit Card (cc requires a 3.6% admin fee added on)

- ✓ Admin fee due when nomination form completed and submitted..... **\$150**

**Balance of Nomination Fees DUE March 25<sup>th</sup>**

- a) CWHBA Registered or Entered & Inspected horse(s) ..... **\$350**
  - Total Fees for CWHBA Registered or Entered & Inspected horse(s) ..... **\$500**
- b) Eligible registered horse(s) OTHER than CWHBA ..... **\$650**
  - Total Fees for Eligible registered horse(s) OTHER than CWHBA ..... **\$800**
- c) 3-in-1 Package (same requirements as above) plus an additional ..... **\$150**
- d) Limited stabling is available during the presentation days. Please contact our office to book

**WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS** – of any horse that is consigned

- a) Withdrawal before August 27<sup>th</sup> all fees refunded except an Admin Fee..... \$150
- b) Withdrawal after the presentation days – Nomination fees refunded at ..... 50%
- c) Withdrawal after the auction site goes live September 15<sup>th</sup> → NO refund

**COMMISSIONS**

A commission will be charged on each horse sold at the following rates:

<b>10%</b>	On the first \$20,000
<b>7.5%</b>	From \$20,001 to \$30,000
<b>5%</b>	From \$30,001 to \$50,000
<b>6% flat fee</b>	On any horse sold for more than \$50,001
No selling commission will be charged for horses who are not sold. The last bidder <b>must</b> be the owner OR agent for this to be valid. The sale admin must be notified <b>immediately</b> after the close of the sale if the bidder represents the owner	

**MINIMUM BIDS**

- Minimum starting bid will be set at \$6,000 for prospects and performance horses
- Minimum starting bid will be set at \$4,000 for weanlings, yearlings, 2-year-olds, broodmares and 3 in 1 package

**FINAL DISBURSEMENTS**

1. CWHBA – Alberta Chapter acts only as a clearing house for funds collected for and on behalf of the seller
2. GST is collected for and on behalf of the seller ONLY when the seller provides a valid GST registration #
3. Consignor’s accounts will be settled when the bank hold has been released from the purchaser’s funds
4. Payments will be sent via Cheque or Wire transfer. Any outstanding amounts owing will be deducted from your payment at this time. Monies will be sent once the bank hold has been released on the incoming payment for your horse(s) – Note out of province and out of country incoming wires payments take longer to clear the bank. Please fill out the attached Wire transfer form and/or provide a printout of your banking info for your wire. If we do not have your wire transfer information a cheque will be sent via Xpress post
5. Each consignor will be issued a single payment to settle the account
6. For multiple consignments, settlement will occur when final purchaser funds are released

<b>August 27<sup>th</sup></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Payment <u>Due</u> for the remainder of the nomination fee(s) for each of your selected horse(s) – Refer to acceptance email for balance owing – this payment is required in order to attend the presentation day.</li> <li>■ In order to attend the Presentation Day, you <u>must</u> be a current member in good standing with CWHBA</li> <li>■ Submit Catalogue notes on the <a href="http://www.canadianwarmbloodauktion.ca">www.canadianwarmbloodauktion.ca</a> portal</li> </ul>
<b>August 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup></b>	<p>Presentation Days – Horses required to come to Old Gate Farm in Olds, AB for one day. Please indicate your preferred day and time on your nomination form and we will do our best to accommodate you. You will be contacted via phone <u>and</u> email to confirm which date and time works best for your horses needs and your schedule.</p> <p style="background-color: yellow;"><b>All horses must have a Current ELISA / Coggins drawn NOT before <b>June 1, 2021</b> to attend the Presentation days. *This test will be valid for sale requirements*</b></p>
<b>Sept 7<sup>th</sup></b>	Send the link of your X-rays to <a href="mailto:admin@cwauktion.ca">admin@cwauktion.ca</a> → these can be taken anytime after <b>July 1<sup>st</sup></b> but the link sent from your vet must be forwarded no sooner than <b>Sept 7<sup>th</sup></b> as there is only a 30-day timeframe for viewing. We don't want any issues by potential buyers on the sale weekend. Please see your consignors' package for required x-ray views – these were included with acceptance email
<b>Sept 10<sup>th</sup></b>	Final Catalogue EDIT day plus send in Show video and photos to be included on your horse's auction page.
<b>Sept 15<sup>th</sup> to Oct 4<sup>th</sup></b>	Tryouts can be booked for your horse with any potential bidders at your own discretion
<b>Sept 15<sup>th</sup></b>	Website goes live <a href="http://www.canadianwarmbloodauktion.ca">www.canadianwarmbloodauktion.ca</a> All available marketing material will be uploaded and vet info will be added as received.
<b>September 22<sup>nd</sup></b>	Insurance form, PPE exam form and Flexion test videos as well as blood drawn <b>Note:</b> These Cannot be performed Before <b>Sept 7<sup>th</sup></b> due to insurance issues! Please see your consignors' package for forms for yourself and your veterinarian to fill out which have been included in acceptance email
<b>Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> – 7:30pm</b>	Zoom call with all consignors. Invite will be sent via email
<b>October 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup></b>	Auction bidding goes live at 00:01 MST on Friday October 1 <sup>st</sup> A member of the sale committee will be in contact with you before the auction goes live to answer any questions or concerns that you may have. They will also be available anytime over the weekend of the sale to answer any questions or help with any technical difficulties
<b>October 4<sup>th</sup> – 7 pm</b>	Sale Closing date – Lots close in 3-minute increments MST
